PROCEDURE

- Round 1 Ten nights. Each team will play Eight (8) games. Each team will have two (2) byes
 Round 1 After night 10 three bottom teams from Division 1 will exchange with three top teams of Division 2
 Round 2 Ten nights. Each team will play Eight (8) games. Each team will have two (2) byes
 Round 2 After night 10 three bottom teams from Division 1 will exchange with three top teams of Division 2
 Round 3 Four (4) divisions of Five (5) teams will be formed. Five nights. Each team will play Four (4) games. Each team will have one (1) bye
 Round 3 After night 5 final standings. The top team in Division 1a will be declared the Thursday Open League Champion.

Tie breakers

1. Record between tied teams for the round
2. Record between tied teams aggregate
3. Wins for the round
4. Draw to the button - Determined and recorded in the first round
5. Wins aggregate
6. Points aggregate

Spare Policy

- (a) A team shall include a minimum of two players from the original team.
- (b) Any member of the Carleton Heights Curling Club may act as a spare for another team at any time as required.
- (c) The spare must be playing in place of a paid member.
- (d) A non-member may be invited into the Carleton Heights Curling Club to curl as a spare on three (3) occasions free of charge during a season. Following the three (3) free games, the individual will be required to obtain a club membership in order to curl in club leagues.
- (e) A spare may only deliver stones in either the Lead or Second positions in the delivery rotation of the team. A spare may act as Skip or Vice-Skip while in the Lead or Second positions in the delivery rotation of the team.
